



Light Freezing Rain Possible Tuesday Morning

OVERVIEW

- A short period of light freezing rain is possible Tuesday morning before precipitation changes to all rain by 10 AM.
- While only a few hundredths of an inch of icing is expected at most, roads (especially secondary roads/parking lots) will quickly become slick and hazardous if the event does materialize as temperatures will initially be below freezing.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <u>Between 2 and 10 AM Tuesday morning.</u> ▪ A changeover to all rain is expected by 10 AM as temperatures rise above freezing.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Even if a small amount of freezing rain falls Tuesday morning, roads will very quickly become slick and hazardous as temperatures will initially be below freezing. ▪ At this time, the highest chance for a little bit of ice is across interior portions of southern VA and NE NC.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ None at this time, although Winter Weather Advisories will likely be needed if confidence in light icing increases.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ It is uncertain whether precipitation arrives before temperatures warm above 32°F by mid-late Thursday morning. ▪ Confidence will increase in the next 12-24 hours.
NEXT BRIEFING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ By 10 AM Monday. ▪ Note that this will also include our full weekly briefing in addition to an update regarding the potential light icing.
