What Has Changed?

- → Winter Storm Warnings have been expanded to include southside Hampton Roads as well as Bertie NC, where 3 to 5" of snow is expected.
- → Winter Weather Advisories have been expanded and now include Accomack and York VA for the potential of 1 to 3" of snow.




- Winter Storm Warnings are now in effect across most of northeast NC, including the northern Outer Banks, as well as southside Hampton Roads, including Norfolk and Va Beach. Overall model confidence and snow has increased over this area, with 3-5" of snow forecast tonight into Wednesday AM. Locally higher amounts will be possible. Winter Weather Advisories are in effect for much of the remainder of southeast VA into interior northeast NC, where 1-3" of snow is expected. A light accumulation of snow (<1") is also possible across the rest of central/eastern VA and the MD eastern shore.
- Remaining very cold through midweek. Daily highs Wednesday will again be in the 20s, with early morning lows in the single digits to mid teens. Prepare now for minimum wind chills as low as 5 to 10 above in the south and near to occasionally below zero across the north each night through Wednesday night/early Thursday.
- Marine Weather A Freezing Spray Advisory is in effect through Wednesday morning, with light to moderate freezing spray expected. Small Craft Advisories are in effect tonight into Wednesday morning.





Winter Storm Watch




Key Points:

- Snow accumulations of 3-5" are expected in the warning area, with locally higher totals possible; 1-3" is expected in the Advisory area (highest in E/SE sections closest to the Warning).
- A light accumulation (<1") of snow is possible a couple tiers of counties west of the advisory area.




Expected Snow Late Today Into Wed



- SNOW AMOUNTS: 3-5" of snow is forecast over coastal northeast NC, with 2-4" in far SE VA. Slightly lower totals are expected just inland, but even 0.5-1" of snow will likely cause minor travel issues given the cold temperatures.
- TIMING: Best timing for snow this evening into early Wednesday morning.
- HAZARDS: Temperatures will be well below freezing and any accumulating snow will likely cause some travel issues.






Snow Character and Peak Snowfall Rate






This will be a very dry, fluffy snow with peak rates of up to 1"/hour. The most likely timing for peak snowfall rate is between 9 PM and 3 AM.





Cold Weather Advisory




Key Points:

- Cold Weather Advisories have been issued for the entire area from tonight-Wednesday AM.
- A 5-15 mph wind and lows in the teens will result in widespread 0-10°F wind chills over the entire area.



Minimum Wind Chills - Tonight



- The combination of air temperatures in the teens and a 5-15 mph wind will lead to wind chills mainly from 0 to 10 degrees later tonight into Wednesday morning.
- Use caution while traveling outside.
 Wear appropriate clothing, a hat, and gloves.


Wind Gust Forecast (mph)




Marine Hazards




Advisories remain in effect for all local waters north of the VA/NC border until 10 AM Wednesday.

FREEZING SPRAY ADVISORY



WHAT: Light to moderate icing accumulation on vessels from freezing spray



WINDS: N to NW 15-25 kt, Gusts to up to 30 Kt over the lower Chesapeake Bay and Atlantic Coastal Waters.



WHERE: Chesapeake Bay from Smith Point to the Mouth of Chesapeake Bay, the York, James, and Rappahannock Rivers, and Atlantic Coastal Waters from Fenwick Island, DE to Cape Charles, VA


WHEN: Tonight through Wednesday morning.

IMPACTS: Freezing spray may damage electronic equipment and can reduce vessel stability












Limited	Wind Gusts >= 20 knots (15 kt Bay & rivers) and/or Waves >= 4 feet (2 ft Bay & rivers).
PIDV/2tPU	Wind Gusts >= 25 knots (20 kt Bay & rivers) and/or Waves >= 5 feet (>=4 ft Bay & rivers).
Significant	Wind Gusts >= 34 knots and/or Waves >= 8 feet (>= 5 ft Bay & rivers).
Extreme	Wind Gusts >= 48 knots and/or Waves >= 12 feet (>= 8 ft Bay & rivers).






