ACLS – <u>Advanced Cardiac Life Support</u> is an advanced course that builds on the foundation of lifesaving BLS skills, emphasizing the importance of

continuous, high-quality CPR, and high-performance team dynamics. Offerings will include provider/initial, renewal/update and HeartCode Checkoffs.



PALS - <u>Pediatric Advanced Life Support</u> uses a series of videos and simulated pediatric emergencies to reinforce the important concepts of

a systematic approach to pediatric assessment, basic life support, PALS treatment algorithms, effective resuscitation, and team dynamics. Offerings will include provider/initial, renewal/update and HeartCode Checkoffs.



PEARS - <u>Pediatric Emergency Assessment</u>, <u>Recognition and Stabilization</u> teaches providers who infrequently deal with pediatrics how to use a systematic approach to quickly assess, recognize

the cause, and stabilize a pediatric patient in an emergency situation.



BLS - <u>Basic Life Support</u> for healthcare professionals trains participants to promptly recognize several life-threatening emergencies, give high-quality CPR, deliver appropriate

ventilations and provide early use of an AED. Offerings will include provider/initial, renewal/update and HeartCode Checkoffs.
