There are 4 Saturday classes scheduled in this program. No classes will be held during Virginia Tech Football games. Each Saturday class will be considered as two classes.

Tuition Cost - \$950.00 Includes Course Text/Online Access, hard copies available at students' expense.

Course Description: Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) certification program is designed to train an individual to function independently in a medical emergency. This course provides the basic knowledge and skills needed to deliver Basic Life Support (BLS) care and is required to progress to more advanced levels of prehospital patient care. Virginia EMT Certification is good for 4-years.

This is a hybrid EMT course which will use the MyLab Brady online learning system. Students will be required to complete online assignments prior to the start of each class. This method of learning allows more classroom time for hands-on education and practice.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

- A criminal history verification check will be obtained through the Virginia Office of EMS for eligibility to continue with the course.
- Students must complete a minimum of 85% of the didactic and labs of the class, Per the Virginia Emergency Medical Services Regulations 12VACS-31-1501.
- Additional required courses will be completed online by the student during the course, which include FEMA IS-100 Introduction to Incident Command; FEMA IS-200 ICS for Single Resources and Initial Action Incidents; FEMA IS-700 NIMS Introduction; FEMA IS-800 Introduction to National Response Framework; TEEX ARW-160 Introduction to Hazardous Materials
